According to the [Indiana Medical Licensing Board Petition for Summary Suspension](#) filed on February 12, 2026, male patients accused Dr. Guirguis of inappropriately touching them, and performing improper prostate, rectal and genital exams while not using gloves. On December 15, 2025, Dr. Guirguis was terminated by the hospital due to “grossly unprofessional conduct”.

Wagner Reese Attorney Jason Reese shared that he takes calls from men who claim they were victims of Dr. Guirguis. “He was basically a sexual predator dressed in a white coat but was somehow allowed to get away with it for years,” Reese stated.
